

Correction for Issue 112 page 69-70 (Boy's Sailboat Romper)



3. Roll garment from top down toward leg openings (*fig. 2*).

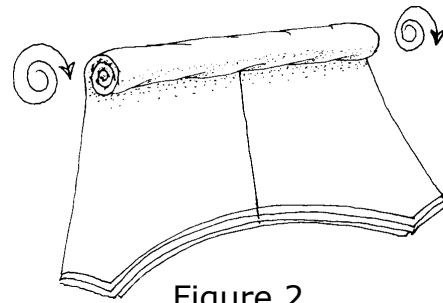

4. Separate left leg opening from right leg opening (you will be stitching the outer romper fabric and the lining together one leg opening at a time) (*fig. 3*).

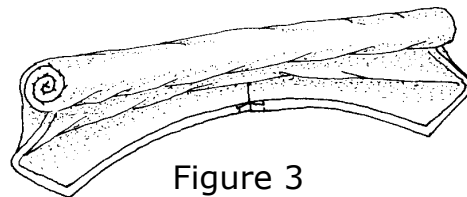

5. Now, working with one leg, separate the lining and the romper fabric by pulling them apart in opposite directions and wrap around the rolled up garment (*fig. 4*).

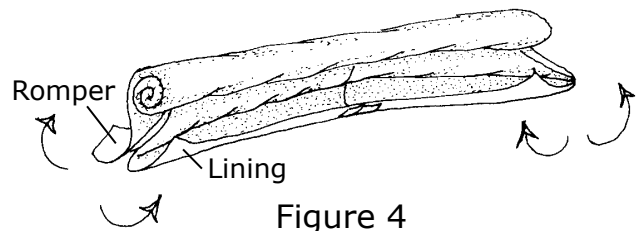

The instructions for applying a full lining to the Dainty Design's Romper is incorrect. The correct steps for finishing the leg openings are provided here. We apologize for any inconvenience.

1. Follow instructions to Step 3.

2. To finish legs, Place romper seams together and flatten garment on it's side (*fig. 1*).

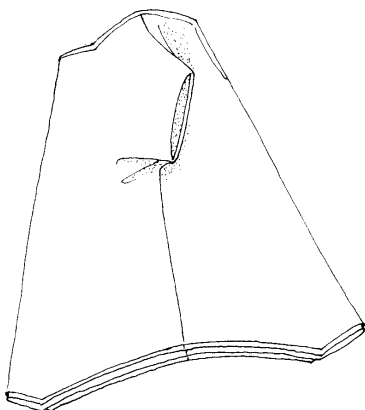

Pin along seam matching side seams and stitch being careful not to catch the garment roll inside (*fig. 5*).

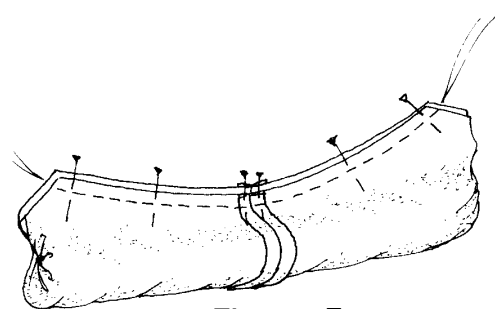

6. Turn the garment inside-out through the tube and repeat for the other leg opening.

This method is the same as the method used in figures 2 and 3 to finish the sleeve edges.
